In November, the Consistory received a letter from the Nominating Committee expressing the difficulty in finding people willing to serve on the Consistory. This was mainly due to the amount of time required for Consistory members to be involved in and at the church on Sundays, due to the two worship services. This committee felt that maybe we should return to having just one worship



service. Many volunteers have also expressed their concern about the amount of time required due to having two services. Also, the amount of volunteers has diminished in numbers and attendance at the 11:00 service only averages about 30 people. The Consistory has discussed this issue at many meetings over and over again in order to make a decision that is in the best interest of the congregation. It was decided at the April 8th meeting that starting June 2 there will only be one worship service. The new schedule will be Sunday School from 8:30-9:15, Coffee Connections from 9:15-9:45, and our Worship Service at 10:00.
