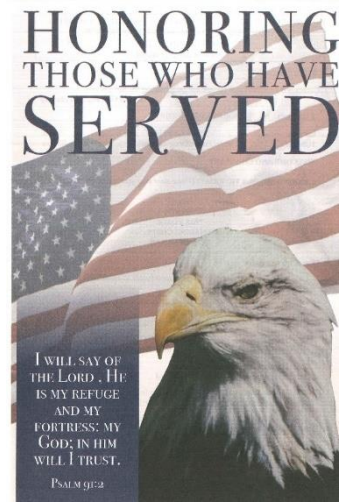

Shiloh UCC is **adopting families** again this year for the Christmas season. This year we have 2 families. We have a single mother with premature twin boys born in September and a 12-year-old son. We also have a grandmother who is raising her grandson and a nephew. Because of Covid and the uncertainty some have about shopping we decided not to place a tree in the gallery. We have volunteers who will use that money to purchase as much as we can from the requested items on their lists. Using a separate envelope designated for Adopt-a Family you can place your donation in the collection plate or mail it in by **November 28th**. The **Soup Kitchen Crew** needs volunteers to prepare spaghetti and serve lunch one day a month at **Our Daily Bread Soup Kitchen in downtown York**. Shiloh UCC is one of many local churches that support Our Daily Bread by supplying and serving food to those in need. **Four volunteers** are needed to serve lunch on the **third Thursday of the month**, and we prepare spaghetti the day before.
