*Call to Worship

People: Let us look to Jesus the Pioneer and Perfector of our faith, who for the joy that was waiting endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

Timothy Bentzel Shiloh United Church of Christ Consistory President:

Shiloh United Church of Christ, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, has called Pastor Melinda as its Pastor and teacher and respectfully requests that the York Association install her in this ministry among us, according to the faith and order of the United Church of Christ.

Association representative:

The York association has reviewed the request of Shiloh United Church of Christ. We have prayerfully examined Pastor Melinda and we are pleased to install her as your pastor and teacher.

Pastor Melinda servant of God, we invite you to come forward as a sign of your acceptance of the call to this office.

Association representative:

Installation is the action of an association of the United Church of Christ in cooperation with a local church. Installation confirms and celebrates the covenantal relationship among a local church, it's pastor and teacher, and the United Church of Christ. Installation is a sign that these covenantal partners are committed to share mutually in the mission of the United Church of Christ and of the ecumenical church.

Exhortation:

Association representative addressing the congregation:

Hear these words from the apostle Paul: we beg you, our brothers and sisters, to pay proper respect to those who work among you, guide and instruct you in the Christian life. Treat them with the greatest respect and love because of the work they do. Be at peace among yourselves.

Addressing the pastor

We urge you, our sister, warn the idol, encourage the timid, help the weak, be patient with all.

Addressing all:

See that no one pays back wrong for wrong, but at all times make it your aim to do good to one another and to all people. Be joyful always, pray at all times, and be thankful in all circumstances. This is what God wants of you, in your life in Christ Jesus. Amen.

Association representative:

Pastor Melinda, seeing that you are called to ordained ministry by the grace of God and that Shiloh United Church of Christ has been led to call you as pastor and teacher, are you willing to enter this covenant with its members who are one in Christ with us in the York association?

Pastor:

I am willing, and I promise to serve this church faithfully, preaching and teaching the word of God, administering the sacraments, and for fulfilling the pastoral office, according to the faith and order of the United Church of Christ.

Association representative addressing the congregation:

Members of Shiloh United Church of Christ, will those who are able please stand and affirm your covenant with your pastor and teacher?

***Local church members: We, the members of Shiloh United Church of Christ, receive Pastor Melinda as our pastor and teacher, promising to labor with her in the ministry of the gospel and to give her due honor and support. We gather with her and with the United Church of Christ as a sign of our mutual Ministry in Christ's name.**

Association representative addressing association members:

Members of the York Association, do you affirm your covenant with Shiloh United Church of Christ and its pastor and teacher?

We the members of the York association of the United Church of Christ together with you the people and the pastor and teacher of Shiloh United Church of Christ, as a sign of our covenant and in celebration of our mutual Ministry in Christ's name.

Association Representative

Let us pray: Almighty God, you have called your servants to make promises before you; now enable us to keep our vows that we may remain steadfast in faith and fruitful in every good work. Bless, we pray, your servant Pastor Melinda to whom the care of your people of this church is now committed. Pour out your Holy Spirit on her and on the people of Shiloh United Church of Christ, as well as all the churches of the York Association that our mutual Ministry maybe served with all faithfulness, diligence, and courage. Grant us the spirit of power, of love and of a sound mind. Make our ministry a means of awakening the careless, strengthening the faithful, comforting the afflicted, building up your church, and converting sinners to you. Guard us against the snares of temptation that we may be kept pure in heart, fervent in spirit, and valiant against evil.
